## City of Atlanta Board of Ethics Retreat Minutes of December 1, 2007

The City of Atlanta Board of Ethics held a board retreat on Saturday, December 1, 2007, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. in the offices of the Southern Education Foundation, 135 Auburn Avenue, Second Floor, Atlanta, GA 30303.
